A Tale of Two Men

A recent development that you may not know of is our **Friday Outreach Ministry**. Led by TLC staff, some of our men have been going into a very needy area of Poughkeepsie to share the love of Christ through the gospel. **Especially wonderful is that two students have come to TLC as a result of this ministry!**

We want to tell you of an elderly gentleman who was a migrant worker from Mexico. In time, he found himself homeless, traveling from shelter to shelter. He speaks very little English. At our first encounter, one of our men showed care by giving him some water. He had many needs, but that was the best that could be done at the time. As it happened the following week, our men brought toiletries to give out. They had not done this before. This gentleman was given a baggie with soap, a toothbrush, and toothpaste. It turned out that just that morning, he had asked God to send him a toothbrush! God answered his prayer! The gentleman has since come to live at TLC. Through a translator, **he has asked Jesus to be his Savior!** We are working with another organization to reunite him with his family in Mexico.

Another man much younger has come to us through this outreach ministry. He had been on his way to make a drug deal when he "happened" to pass through where our men were sharing the gospel. He heard the word, realized it was an opportunity to get out of the life he was in, left it all behind, and came to TLC. **This young man received Jesus as his Savior just last week.** Praise the Lord!
